POD #1 - Install one (1) H.P. jet pump in the unnamed creek. Water
will be pumped through a garden hose 300 feet to water garden
and lawn.

POD #2 - One-half (1/2) H.P. Jacuzzi submersible pump. Well was dug in
1977 with backhoe into pervious strata of sand and gravel and
was gravel packed with 8 cubic yards of drain field rock.
Well intercepts surface water from the adjacent unnamed creek.
Well is 24-inch galvanized CMP 8 feet deep.

If for domestic use state number of families to be supplied One (1) family.

7. Construction work will begin on or before August 2, 1979

8. Construction work will be completed on or before August 2, 1982 or three (3) years

9. The water will be completely applied to the proposed use on or before Three (3) years

Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from an unnamed stream.

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation and domestic use for one family; being 0.005 c.f.s. for irrigation, and 0.005 c.f.s. for domestic use.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is January 29, 1979

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 24, 1980 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1981

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1982
