DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Include dimensions and type of construction of diversion dam and headgate, length and dimensions of supply ditch or pipeline, size and type of pump and motor, type of irrigation system to adequately describe the proposed distribution system.

FROM THE POINT OF DIVERSION I WILL HAVE A 20' LONG 1/4" DIAMETER INPUT PIPE INTO A 3/4 HORSEPOWER ELECTRIC MOTOR DRIVEN PUMP. THE PUMP WILL FEED A 400' LONG 1/4" DIAMETER MAIN DISTRIBUTION PIPE LINE RUNNING NORTH FROM THE POINT OF DIVERSION. FROM THE DISTRIBUTION LINE I WILL HAVE BRANCH LINES OF 1/4" DIAMETER AND 120' LONG WITH FOUR RAINBIRD SPRINKLERS ON EACH. I WILL HAVE SEVEN BRANCH LINES OF 120' RUNNING EAST & WEST. I WILL ALSO HAVE TWO SPICKETS FOR THE PURPOSE OF LIVESTOCK WATERING. THEY WILL BE LOCATED 25' AND 400' NORTH OF THE POINT OF DIVERSION

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Permit to appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.025 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Applegate River.

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation and livestock use; being 0.02 c.f.s. for irrigation, and 0.005 c.f.s. for livestock.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is March 19, 1979

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 11, 1980 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1981

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1982
