6. DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

The difference in elevation between intake and place of use is approximately 40 feet. Grade is uniform. This will have a small earth and rock dam in the main channel of a small creek about 5 feet in length and 18 inches high. The creek show no signs of extreme high or low water runoffs. This is gravity system with about 550 feet of one inch plastic pipe. The intake will be screened.

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Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.005 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from an unnamed stream

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic use for one family

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is March 27, 1979

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 11, 1980 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1981

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1982
