A parcel of land situated in Government Lots Three (3) and Four (4) of Section Twenty-nine (29) and in Government Lot Four (4) of Section Thirty-two (32), Township Twenty-five (25) South, Range Eleven (11) West of the Willamette Meridian, Coos County, Oregon, described as follows:

Beginning at the most Easterly Northeast corner of the parcel of land deeded by E. L. Bessey, et al to Louise C. Lockhard by deed recorded November 8, 1905 in Deed Book 42, Page 305, Records of Coos County, Oregon, said point being on the South boundary of South Fork of Coos River Market Road; thence Southeasterly along said boundary of said road 510 feet; thence South 39° 15' West parallel to the Southeast Boundary of said Lockhard tract to the mean low water line of South Fork of Coos River; thence down stream Northwesterly along said low water line 510 feet, more or less, to a point south 39° 15' West of the point of beginning; thence North 39° 15' East to the point of beginning.

4. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.045 cfs  
cubic feet per second. with any deficiency in supply to be supplemented  
by appropriation from S. Fork of Coos River

Permit to appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.045 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from an unnamed stream with any deficiency in the available of water from the stream to be made up by diversion of water from Coos River.

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic use for one family and irrigation; being 0.005 c.f.s. for domestic use, and 0.04 c.f.s. for irrigation.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is March 8, 1979

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 11, 1980 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1981

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1982
