APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Roy Welter (Name of Applicant) of Wonder (Postoffice), Josephine County of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the

following described public waters of the State of Oregon subject to existing rights:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Bridge Gulch (Name of stream)

tributary of Slate Creek (Applegate)

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.20 cubic feet per second.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Domestic (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located Commencing at the SE corner of Section 17; thence west 140 rods; thence North 60 rods. (Give distance and bearing to section corner)

5. The pipe line to be 1120 feet (Main ditch, canal or pipe line)

terminating in the NE 1/4 of SW 1/4 of Sec. 17, Tp. 37 S (No. N. or S.)

R. 7 W, W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map. (No. E. or W.)

6. The name of the ditch, canal or other works is Welter Pipe Line

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent, for each acre irrigated, and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The right to the use of water herein granted is limited to domestic purposes

The amount of water appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use and not to exceed 0.1 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of

rotation. The priority date of this permit is January 28, 1920

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 13, 1921 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 1, 1922

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1923
