make application for a permit to appropriate the following described waters of the State of Oregon:

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Spring fed pool lying within the boundary of our property, a tributary of None

2. The point of diversion is to be located 100 ft. South and 495 ft. West from the NE corner of Section 14 Township 19 South Range 12 West Willamette Meridian (Public Land Survey Corner) (If there is more than one point of diversion, each must be described)

being within the NE NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 14 Tp. 19 S R. 12 W, W. M., in the county of Lane

6. DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

We have a shallow well pressure system at the edge of the small pool (spring fed) - from there the water is piped up the slope to the house.

There is no stream flowing into the pool, only spring flow but there is a small flow from the lower end which runs on down the canyon for approx. 200 yds and into Washenb Lake.

This entire pool, system etc lies within our Lot # 110

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Permit to appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from an unnamed stream.

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic use for one family, including the irrigation of lawn and garden not to exceed 1/2 acre in area.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated.

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is March 23, 1979

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 11, 1980 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1981

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1982
