- 2. The point of diversion is to be located #1 1126 172 WEST EAST, #2 1870 ft. North and 1640 ft. EAST (N. or S.) (E. or W.)

from the SW 1/4 corner of 12 (Public Land Survey Corner)

6. DESCRIPTION OF WORKS  
 Include dimensions and type of construction of diversion dam and headgate, length and dimensions of supply ditch or pipeline, size and type of pump and motor, type of irrigation system to adequately describe the proposed distribution system.

POD #1 - Our diversion dam is approximately 4' wide and 4' deep. This water will be gravity fed into a 24,000 gallon 1/2" steel holding tank approximately 350'-400' from this diversion tank.

The main distribution line (POD #1) will be approximately 3" in diameter. This water line will provide water for our sprinkler system located within the 30 campsites at Powers Park.

POD #2 - The 20 H.P. pump is 3 phase, 60 cycle (3,490 rpm), full load, is located adjacent to the South Fork of the Coquille River. This pump has a 6" intake and outlet which carries water approximately 1,400' to our man-made pond.

- 7. Construction work will begin on or before 3-01-78

- 9. The water will be completely applied to the proposed use on or before 5-01-81

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Remarks: AT THIS TIME, THE CITY OF POWERS IS HAVING A DIFFICULT TIME PROVIDING POWERS PARK WITH ADEQUATE WATER. THESE ADDITIONAL WATER SYSTEMS WILL PROVIDE WATER FOR OUR WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT AS WELL AS REDUCE OUR COST TO PROVIDE NEEDED DRINKING AND IRRIGATION WATER FOR POWERS PARK.

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Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.13 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream; or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Morris Creek and South Fork Coquille River.

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation and commercial use in a public park including fish culture; being 0.10 c.f.s. from Morris Creek for irrigation, and 0.03 c.f.s. from South Fork Coquille River for commercial use.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is August 18, 1978

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 30, 1980 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1981

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1982
