a tributary of Black Canyon Creek

from the NE corner of SE 1/4, Section 3, T. 17S., R. 34E., W.M.  
(Public Land Survey Corner)

6. DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Include dimensions and type of construction of diversion dam and headgate, length and dimensions of supply ditch or pipeline, size and type of pump and motor, type of irrigation system to adequately describe the proposed distribution system.

36" wide x 24" deep x 36" high metal spring box is buried at the source to collect water. 20' of 1 1/2" metal pipe is buried under the surface and runs from the box to a 30" x 12' metal stock water trough. 20' of 1 1/2" metal pipe serves as an overflow from the trough to return the water to below the surface.

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### Permit to appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.005 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from McAllister Spring.

The use to which this water is to be applied is stock water.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated.

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is April 9, 1979

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 20, 1980 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1981

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1982
