make application for a permit to appropriate the following described waters of the State of Oregon:

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is AXTEL CREEK
a tributary of YACHATS RIVER

2. The point of diversion is to be located 2150 ft. South and 1550 ft. West
(N. or S.) (E. or W.)
from the northeast corner of Section 34
(Public Land Survey Corner)

being within the southwest quarter of the northeast quarter of Section

4. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 1/80th of a cubic foot per second, from one source, Axtel Crk
(If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

5. The use to which the water is to be applied is Domestic use, Lawn and Garden - 1/2
acre.

6. DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Include dimensions and type of construction of diversion dam and headgate, length and dimensions of supply ditch or pipeline, size and type of pump and motor, type of irrigation system to adequately describe the proposed distribution system.

A 1/2 HP electric pump would be placed in a submersible position in a covered recessed cement casing, with gravel bottom. Water would enter the cement casing, after being filtered through the gravel. The water would be pumped through a 1" plastic pipe to the property of the applicants. The water will be piped to the house of applicants and to an outside outlet for their garden.

Permit to appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Axtel Creek.

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic use for one family, including the irrigation of lawn and garden not to exceed 1/2 acre in area.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is April 13, 1979

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 20, 1980 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1981

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1982
