1. The source of the proposed appropriation is North Fork of Lake Creek

a tributary of Lake Creek & tributaries of the Metolius River

2. The point of diversion is to be located 500 ft. S and 40 ft. E
(N. or S.) (E. or W.)

from the NW corner of Sec 15, T13S, R9E, W.M.
(Public Land Survey Corner)



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Remarks: This application is being filed in order to cover the full area we have been irrigating for the last 35 yrs or more under the assumption our 1908 right covered the full area. The total area being irrigated is 305,000 sq' or 7.0 acres. (385' x 660' x 540' - the hypotenuse was not measured). Inasmuch as the existing ¹⁹⁰⁸ right is for 5.1 acres, this was subtracted from the ^{total} 7.00 acres being irrigated under this 1908 right. The additional specific areas covered by the 1.9 additional acres are denoted on the map in solid black.

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Permit to appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.03 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from North Fork Lake Creek.

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/60th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is April 30, 1979

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 13, 1980 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1981

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1982
