DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Include dimensions and type of construction of diversion dam and headgate, length and dimensions of supply ditch or pipeline, size and type of pump and motor, type of irrigation system to adequately describe the proposed distribution system.

Permanent pump site on stream #3 only. Portable pumping from streams #1, #2, and #4 will use portable pump and sprinkler system on many areas, other areas may be flood irrigated by ditches.

Source of water for the five (5) unnamed natural sloughs is from irrigation and natural drainage of above land.

Flow as measured on applicant's property is considered natural flow of the five sources because any portion of the flow which originated as waste water on above land is beyond the control of the original appropriator.

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Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 10.3 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from four unnamed streams.

The use to which this water is to be applied is supplemental irrigation; being 1.65 c.f.s. from stream #1 with deficiency from stream #3, 3.11 c.f.s. from stream #1 with any deficiency from stream #2 and further deficiency from stream #3, 0.71 c.f.s. from stream #2 with any deficiency from stream #3, 2.84 c.f.s. from stream #4 with any deficiency from stream #3, and 2.0 c.f.s. from stream #3.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/40th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein.

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is May 20, 1977

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 13, 1980 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1981

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1982
