

APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Pacific Placer Company (Name of Applicant) of Murphy, County of Jackson, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon subject to existing rights:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is O'Brien and Sturgis Forks (Name of stream)

tributary of Carberry Fork (Applegate R)

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 8.00 cubic feet per second.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Placer Mining (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located Commencing at the NE corner of Sec. 14; thence east 100 rods; thence south 120 rods; and commencing at same corner, thence north 100 rods, thence east 15 rods.

being within the 1st SW 1/4 of NE 14 of Sec. 12, Tp. 40 S, R. 5 W, W. M., in the county of Josephine (No. N. or S.)

5. The ditch to be 7 1/2 miles in length, terminating in the SE 1/4 of NE 23 of Sec. 23, Tp. 39 S, R. 5 W, W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

6. The name of the ditch, canal or other works is Layton Ditch Extension of Thompson Creek Irrigation Association Ditch

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent, for each acre irrigated, and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. The right to the use of water herein granted is limited to Placer mining purposes, During the season from November 1st to July 20th of the next succeeding year.

The amount of water appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use and not to exceed 8.0 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The priority date of this permit is February 6, 1920

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 20, 1921 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 1, 1922

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1923
