### Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 22.2 acre feet stored water only ~~22.2 cubic feet per second~~ measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Cinnamon Reservoir and Phalarope Reservoir; being 2.0 a.f. from Cinnamon Reservoir, and 20.2 a.f. from Phalarope Reservoir, to be constructed under application No. R-53360, permit No. R-7836.

The use to which this water is to be applied is supplemental irrigation.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to ~~XXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXX one cubic foot per second~~ or its equivalent for each acre irrigated a diversion of 4 1/2 acre feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.


