make application for a permit to appropriate the following described waters of the State of Oregon:

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Unnamed Stream and
East Fork Evans Creek, a tributary of Evans Creek.

2. The point of diversion is to be located 450 ft. S. (N. or S.) and 1480 ft. E. (E. or W.)
from the N¹/₄ corner of Section 19, being within the NE¹/₄ NE¹/₄ of
Section 19; (Public Land Survey Corner)

The East Fork Evans Creek Diversion is located 1200 feet south and 1120
feet East from the North quarter corner of Section 19

being within the NW 1/₄ of the NE 1/₄ of
Sec. 19 / Tp. 34 S. (N. or S.) R. 2 W. (E. or W.), W. M., in the county of Jackson.

Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.075 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from an unnamed stream and East Fork Evans Creek; being 0.005 c.f.s. from the unnamed stream, and 0.07 c.f.s. from East Fork Evans Creek.

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic use for one family and irrigation; being 0.005 c.f.s. from the unnamed stream for domestic use, and 0.07 c.f.s. from East Fork Evans Creek for irrigation.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is May 16, 1979

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 8, 1980 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1981

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1982
