make application for a permit to appropriate the following described waters of the State of Oregon:

- 1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Two unnamed streams and Oster Reservoir, a tributary of Rock Creek Stream A. 2. The point of diversion is to be located 200 ft. N and 300 ft. W from the N 1/4 corner of Sec 4 T-6S., R. 1E

both being within the SE 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Sec. 33 Tp. 5S R. 1E, W. M., in the county of Clatsop

Permit to appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 1.0 acre feet stored water only measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Oster Reservoir to be constructed under application No. R-58797, permit No. R-7838.

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation and stock; being 0.9 acre feet for irrigation and 0.1 acre feet for stock.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to a diversion of 2 1/2 acre feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is June 18, 1979

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 31, 1980 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1981

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1982
