6. DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

A 36 INCH SUMP WILL BE PLACED IN CREEK BED AT THE EDGE TO RECEIVE WATER THROUGH A 3 INCH PERFORATED PIPE LAID IN STREAM BED. THE 3 INCH X LINE WILL RUN FOR ABOUT 50' AS A TIGHT LINE AND ABOUT 20' AS PERFORATED. A SUBMERSABLE PUMP WILL BE INSTALLED IN SUMP TO PUMP WATER TO A LARGE CONCRETE RESERVOIR (ABOUT 2000 GAL CAST-IN-PLACE). A PUMP WILL PUMP FROM RESERVOIR TO PROVIDE PRESSURE TO THE HOME. AUTOMATIC CONTROLS WILL BE INSTALLED TO KEEP SYSTEM UP TO PRESSURE, THE RESERVOIR FULL AND TO KEEP SUBMERSABLE PUMP FROM RUNNING DRY.

X A SHALLOW PITCH WILL BE RUN IN STREAM BED TO ALLOW 3 INCH LINE TO BE BURIED WITH COARSE GRAVEL TO PREVENT PICKING UP SAND.

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Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Baker Creek.

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic use for one family including the irrigation of lawn and garden not to exceed 1/2 acre in area.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated.

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is April 30, 1979

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 31, 1980 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1981

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1982
