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Hulick Branch diversion located 45 rods South of the center of Sec. 16, T3S., R.40 E.W.M., being within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4, and then various points of the land of applicant wherever he finds it necessary to divert water to irrigate his land, the stream being so small, acts as an irrigation ditch.

Mill Creek.

Diversion No. I 6 rods N. & 4 rods E. of the S 1/4 corner Sec. 16 T3S R.40 E.W.M being within the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of said section.

Diversion No. II 2 rods S. 36 rods W. of S 1/4 corner Sec. 16, T3S., R. 40 E.W.M on the S. line of sec. 16, being within the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Sec. 21, T.3S., R. 40 E.W.M.

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Permit to appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 1.23 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Mill Creek and Hulick Branch.

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation. The use allowed herein may be made any time between September 1 and March 31 when water can be put to beneficial use by irrigation, either for immediate crop growth or for forecast requirements to raise the soil moisture to field capacity in the soil profile to be utilized by plant growth in the subsequent growing season.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the period from April 1 to August 31 and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 1 acre foot per acre for each acre irrigated during the period from September 1 to March 31, provided further that the right allowed herein shall not exceed 3 acre feet for each acre irrigated in any one year. The use of water during the period from September 1 to March 31 as authorized herein shall not establish priority of right as against future appropriations of surface water for beneficial uses or for storage for such beneficial uses other than similar rights for irrigation from September 1 to March 31. Sufficient flow shall be left in Mill Creek and Hulick Branch to provide stockwater throughout its course during the period of use authorized herein.

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is August 9, 1979

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 31, 1980 and shall

thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1981

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1982
