SOMETIME PRIOR TO 1933 A RESERVOIR WAS CONSTRUCTED AT THIS SPRING. IT IS A STONE AND MOTOR SHELL WITH A WOOD SUPER-STRUCTURE AND A SHEET METAL ROOF WITH A SCREEN FRONT. THE SIZE IS APPROXIMATELY 8' X 15' X 4' DEEP. THIS RESERVOIR AT ONE TIME SERVED A NUMBER OF FAMILIES IN THE AREA BUT SINCE HAS BEEN REPLACED BY THE SOUTH PRAIRIE WATER SYSTEM. WE WOULD BE USING GRAVITY FLOW TO THE EXISTING HOUSE ON THE PROPERTY

### Permit to appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from a spring

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic use for three families including irrigation of lawns and gardens not exceeding 1/2 acre in area for each

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is July 12, 1979

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 17, 1980 and shall

thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1981

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1982
