make application for a permit to appropriate the following described waters of the State of Oregon:

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is A Spring and Unnamed Stream, trib. of Squaw Creek, a tributary of Applegate River.

2. The point of diversion is to be located 1040 ft. N. and 1650 ft. W. from the E 1/4 corner of Sec. 4, being within the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Sec. 4; (Public Land Survey Corner)

(If there is more than one point of diversion, each must be described) Unnamed Stream diversion point is located 850' N. and 580' W. from the E 1/4 corner of Section 4

being within the SE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Sec. 4, both in Tp. 41 S. R. 3 W., W. M., in the county of Jackson.

3. Location of area to be irrigated, or place of use if other than irrigation.

Water diverted into pipeline, being 600 feet of 4" and 900 feet of 3"  
-- all gravity system for supplemental irrigation.  
Spring to be boxed in using 3 feet of 18" concrete tile --  
Water then piped to house for domestic use using 800 feet of 1-inch  
plastic pipe.

### Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.085 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from a spring and unnamed stream

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic use for one family and irrigation; being 0.005 c.f.s. from the spring for domestic use and 0.08 c.f.s. from the unnamed stream for irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is July 18, 1979

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 17, 1980 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1981

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1982
