make application for a permit to appropriate the following described waters of the State of Oregon:

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is SPRING, a tributary of Catching Slough

2. The point of diversion is to be located 1270 ft. S (N. or S.) and 250 ft. W (E. or W.) from the N 1/4 corner of Sec 5 (Public Land Survey Corner)

(If there is more than one point of diversion, each must be described)

being within the NE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Sec. 5 Tp. 26S (N. or S.) R. 12W (E. or W.), W. M., in the county of Coos

3. Location of area to be irrigated, or place of use if other than irrigation.

6' x 12' manmade Reservoir with 2' x 6' cedar lining. 30" headgate + 3/4" overflow + 400' of 1" 180 lbs poly pipe. This will be gravity fed into 1200 gallon storage tank + pumped 100 ft to house by 1/4 horsepower Fairbanks - Morris shallow well pump.

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Permit to appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from a spring

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic use for one family including irrigation of a lawn and garden not to exceed 1/2 acre in area

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is July 27, 1979

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 17, 1980 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1981

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1982
