make application for a permit to appropriate the following described waters of the State of Oregon:

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is unnamed stream and Coker Butte Reservoir, (see remarks), a trib. of S.F. Upton Slough Rogue River, a tributary of

2. The point of diversion & reservoir 1290 ft. S. and 1210 ft. W. from the NE corner of Section 8, being within the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of section 8, T. 37S., R. 1W., W.M. (Public Land Survey Corner)

(If there is more than one point of diversion, each must be described) Diversion point from S.F. Little Butte Creek is to located 600' S. & 525' W. from the E 1/4 corner of Section 29

being within the NE 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Sec. 29 Tp. 36S. R. 2E., W. M., in the county of Jackson

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Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 2.71 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the

stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from an unnamed stream, with any deficiency in the available supply of water from the unnamed stream to be made up by diversion of water from the South Fork of Little Butte Creek and Coker Butte Reservoir to be constructed under Application No. R-59356, Permit No. R-7949

The use to which this water is to be applied is temperature control, provided the permittee shall record and submit annually to the Water Resources Department all pertinent data pertaining to use of water for temperature control on forms furnished.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is September 24, 1979

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 14, 1980 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1981

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1982
