1. The source of the proposed appropriation is an unnamed stream, trib. of Slide Creek; and Slide Cr., a tributary of N. Myrtle Cr.

2. The point of diversion is to be located ft. and ft. from the S 1/4 corner of Sec. 34

Div. #1 (Unn. Str.): 50' N. and 460' W. Div. #2 (Slide Cr.): 420' N. and 1020' W.

both being within the SE 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Sec. 34 Tp. 28S. R. 4W., W. M., in the county of Douglas

3. Location of area to be irrigated, or place of use if other than irrigation.

An old Bridge has Fallen in Slide Creek and Formed a small Diversion. The water running over the timbers have washed out a deep hole on the Down side. sufficient to place a suction base for pump. We will be using a 5 horse pump with 1000 ft of 3 inch pipe and 15 rain Bird Sprinklers with .030 hole.

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### Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.243 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Slide Creek and an unnamed creek; being 0.238 c.f.s. from Slide Creek and 0.005 c.f.s. from the unnamed creek

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation and domestic use for one family; being 0.238 c.f.s. from Slide Creek for irrigation and 0.005 c.f.s. from the unnamed creek for domestic use

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is July 27, 1979

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 14, 1980 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1981

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1982
