make application for a permit to appropriate the following described waters of the State of Oregon:

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is The SYCAN RIVER, a tributary of The Sprague River

2. The point of diversion is to be located 565 ft. S (N. or S.) and 1206 ft. W (E. or W.) from the NE corner of Section 3 IN T36S R12EWM (Public Land Survey Corner)

(If there is more than one point of diversion, each must be described)

being within the NE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Sec. 3 Tp. 36S R. 12E, W.M., in the county of Klamath

3. Location of area to be irrigated, or place of use if other than irrigation.

4. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 1.89

5. The use to which the water is to be applied is Irrigating alfalfa

6. DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Include dimensions and type of construction of diversion dam and headgate, length and dimensions of supply ditch or pipeline, size and type of pump and motor, type of irrigation system to adequately describe the proposed distribution system.

1. ONE 50 horse power 4YB pump
2. 1770 feet of 8 inch Supply line
3. 2210 feet of 6 inch mainline with valves every 60 feet
4. 1920 foot, 5 inch wheel line with #70 Rainbird heads
5. 1280 foot, 4 inch wheel line with #70 Rainbird heads

If for domestic use state number of families to be supplied.....

7. Construction work will begin on or before Sept. 1979

8. Construction work will be completed on or before May 1980

9. The water will be completely applied to the proposed use on or before June 1980

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Remarks: actual work cannot be started before issuance of the permit. We have all pipe needed ready to be delivered.

Permit to appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 1.89 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Sycan River

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/40th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is August 22, 1979

Actual construction work shall begin on or before December 6, 1980 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1981

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1982
