I do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described waters of the State of Oregon:

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is an unnamed stream, winter run-off and a spring and 2 reservoirs, a tributary of N. Yamhill River

2. The point of diversion is to be located * ft. (N. or S.) and ft. (E. or W.)
 from the center corner of Sec. 12 (Public Land Survey Corner)

Spring 1080' S and 650' E being within the NW 1/4 of the SE 1/4
 (If there is more than one point of diversion, each must be described)

Unnamed 1435' S and 1040' E being within the SW 1/4 of the SE 1/4

Run-off 900' S and 1345' W being within the NW 1/4 of the SW 1/4

Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from spring, unnamed stream, winter runoff and reservoirs No. 1 and No. 2 to be constructed under application No. R-58766, permit No. R-7975

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic use for two families including not to exceed 1/2 acre lawn and non-commercial garden irrigation for each and stock being 0.005 c.f.s. from the unnamed stream and reservoir No. 1 for stock use

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated

** 0.005 c.f.s. from winter runoff and reservoir No. 2 for stock use and 0.01 c.f.s. from the spring for domestic use

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is June 11, 1979

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 7, 1981 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1981

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1982
