Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed0.07..... cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, froman unnamed draw and 8.0..... acre feet stored water only from Inman Reservoir to be constructed under appli-..... cation No. R-58190, permit No. R-7983

The use to which this water is to be applied is.....supplemental irrigation and recreation,..... being 8.0 acre feet stored water only for irrigation and 0.07 cubic foot of water... per second for recreation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to1/40th..... of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated..... and shall be further limited to a diversion of not... to exceed 3 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation..... season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be..... limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing..... for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
