do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described waters of the State of Oregon:

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Little Pickett Creek with any deficiency

coming from the Rogue River, a tributary of Little Pickett is a tributary of the Rogue River

2. The point of diversion is to be located 420 ft. south and 530 ft. west  
(N. or S.) (E. or W.)

from the northeast corner of SWSE being within the SWSE of Sec. 23 Tp. 35S, R 7WWM  
(Public Land Survey Corner)

in Josephine County; the Rogue River point of diversion is to be located 580 ft.

(If there is more than one point of diversion, each must be described)

south and 675 feet west from the northeast corner of NESE of Sec. 23, Tp. 35S,

R. 7W WM

being within the NE  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SE  $\frac{1}{4}$  of

Sec. 23 Tp. 35S R. 7W, W. M., in the county of Josephine

4. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is .1525  
cubic feet per second from Little Pickett Cr. with any deficiency from the Rogue River  
(If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

5. The use to which the water is to be applied is .1225 cfs for irrigation and .03 cfs for  
three separate domestic uses

6. **DESCRIPTION OF WORKS**

*Include dimensions and type of construction of diversion dam and headgate, length and dimensions of supply ditch or pipeline, size and type of pump and motor, type of irrigation system to adequately describe the proposed distribution system.*

A 7-10 HP pump will be used to draw water directly from Little Pickett Creek and  
into a 4 inch PVC plastic mainline pipe. A series of 2" and 3" laterals will be  
used to convey the water from the mainline to the specific areas of application.  
The mainline will extend to the Rogue River so that water can be pumped into it  
from either point of diversion. A crude map showing the general intended layout  
is attached.

### Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.135 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Pickett Creek with any deficiency in the available supply of water to be made up by appropriation of water from the Rogue River

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic use for three families and irrigation, being 0.01 c.f.s. for domestic use and 0.125 c.f.s. for irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is November 23, 1979

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 7, 1981 and shall

thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1981  
Extended to Oct. 1, 1983 Extended to Oct. 1, 1984

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1982
