make application for a permit to appropriate the following described waters of the State of Oregon:

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Woodcock Creek + 3 raceways of stored water, a tributary of Willamette River

2. The point of diversion is to be located 120 ft. South and 700 ft. E from the NW corner of Sec. 31 of the S.E. 1/4 of sect. 31, T.29S, R. 8W, W.M. (If there is more than one point of diversion, each must be described)

being within the SW 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Sec. 31, Tp. 39S, R. 8W, W.M., in the county of Josephine

3. Location of area to be irrigated, or place of use if other than irrigation.

4. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 150,000 Gallons
cubic feet per second. To fill raceways & not to exceed 10 Gals per
(If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)
minute for maintaining water quality in raceways.

5. The use to which the water is to be applied is To ^{Maintain} ~~fill~~ raceways and the
feeding of Trout.

6. DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

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Remarks: This water is to be used for the Rearing of Trout in cement raceways. When Trout are harvested water will be pumped to Pasture Land.

Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 10 gallons per minute ~~cubic feet per second~~ measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Woodcock Creek and three trout raceways to be constructed under application No. R-59517, permit No. R-7986

The use to which this water is to be applied is trout rearing

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is December 10, 1979

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 7, 1981 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1981

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1982
