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Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.04 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from two springs and an unnamed stream, being 0.01 c.f.s. from each spring and 0.02 c.f.s. from the unnamed stream

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic use for seven families including not to exceed 1/2 acre lawn and non-commercial garden irrigation for each family, being 0.01 c.f.s. from spring No. 1 for one family, 0.01 c.f.s. from spring No. 2

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated

for two families, and 0.02 c.f.s. from the unnamed stream for four families.

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is May 14, 1979

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 7, 1981 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1981

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1982
