DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

A 3'x3' CATCH BASIN TO BE DUG AND USED AS THE INLET FOR 1/2 HP PUMP AND 42 GAL PRESSURE STORAGE TANK. FROM TANK TO APPROVED PURIFIER UNIT TO A NON-PRESSURIZED POLY STORAGE TANK OF APPROXIMATELY 1500 GALLONS. FROM STORAGE TANK TO 1/2 HP PUMP AND 42 GALLON PRESSURIZED STORAGE TANK TO SUPPLY LINE TO HOUSE.

If for domestic use state number of families to be supplied ONE

7. Construction work will begin on or before APPROVAL OF APPLICATION

8. Construction work will be completed on or before DECEMBER 31, 1979

9. The water will be completely applied to the proposed use on or before DECEMBER 31, 1979

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Remarks: WE HAVE DRILLED FOUR (4) WELLS RANGING IN DEPTH FROM 150' MAX TO 120' MIN. 1ST WELL CAME IN AT 2 1/2 GALLONS P/M AT 150' AND SALTY. 2ND & 3RD WELL NO TRACE OF WATER. 4TH WELL - 10 GALLONS P/M AT 120' VERY SALTY & HARD. AFTER THE DISAPPOINTMENT AND EXPENSE OF 4 WELLS I FEEL THE FREE FLOWING STREAM IS OUR ANSWER.

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Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.005 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Douglas Creek

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic use for one family

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated


and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is June 26, 1979

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 7, 1981 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1981

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1982
