THIS IS A OLD SPRING THAT HAD SUNK LEAVING A hole ABOUT 14' X 16' #. IT HAS had some flow in the past couple of years but, it needed to be dug out or cleaned out! WHEN I CLEANED IT OUT, IT BEGAN TO flow freely again. WATER WILL BE SIFONED IN PLASTIC PIPE TO THE POND. THE POND IS SEVERAL YRS OLD, AND IT IS STOCKED WITH LARGE MOUTH BASS, CRAPPIE, BLUE GILL, & CHANNEL CAT, THE FISH WERE STOCKED IN 1976. THERE WILL BE ABOUT 8 OR 10 head OF CATTLE. THE CATTLE WILL DRINK FROM A WATERING TANK. WATER WILL BE SIFONED FROM THE SPRING RESAUIR, FOR ABOUT 10 HEAD OF HOG'S

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Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.395 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from a spring

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic use for one family, fish culture, irrigation and stock use, being 0.005 cfs for domestic use, 0.01 cfs for fish culture, 0.37 cfs for irrigation and 0.01 cfs for stock use.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is November 29, 1979

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 9, 1981 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1982

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1983
