

APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

CERTIFICATE NO. 4911

To Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, K. K. Brainard (Name of Applicant)

of Golden, (Postoffice), County of Josephine

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon subject to existing rights:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Post Gulch and two springs (Name of stream)

tributary of Coyote Creek (Grave Cr.)

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 10/80, .13 cubic feet per second.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is irrigation (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located 160 rods from section corner of Sec. 15-16-21-22 and 170 rods from same corner respectively. (Give distance and bearing to section corner)

being within the SW 1/4 of NE 1/4 of Sec. 21, Tp. 33 S (No. N. or S.)

R. 5W, W. M., in the county of Josephine (No. E. or W.)

5. The ditch to be 50yds (Main ditch, canal or pipe line) miles in length, terminating in the SW 1/4 of NE 1/4 of Sec. 21, Tp. 33S (Smallest legal subdivision) (No. N. or S.)

R. 5W, W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map. (No. E. or W.)

6. The name of the ditch, canal or other works is no name

7. (a) Height of dam 1 feet, length on top 3 feet, length at bottom 4 feet; material to be used and character of construction dirt and brush around dam (Loose rock, concrete, masonry, rock and brush, timber crib, etc., wasteway over or around dam)

(b) Description of headgate one foot gate made of boards (Timber, concrete, etc., number and size of openings)

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent, for each acre irrigated, and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The right to the use of water herein granted is limited to irrigation purposes,

The amount of water appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use and not to exceed 0.13 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The priority date of this permit is March 8, 1920

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 27th, 1921, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 1, 1922.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1923.
