4. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is ~~770~~ <sup>NSD</sup> .070 cubic feet per second. Intire Amount of water to be taken from Pond at this Pond being filled from butler creek Approx 95% Time

5. The use to which the water is to be applied is irrigation and stock care - .065 cubic feet per sec. To be used for irrigation .005 cubic feet per sec. to be used for stock watering

6. DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

A Two H.P. centrifical pump will be installed to supply water to a 2" plastic pipe which will be 400 feet long with 200 feet of one inch plastic pipe Feeder Lines which will feed 5 3/4" valves -

I intend to water Four Head of cattle, - Three head of Hogs and A few chickens - The method of watering will be by way of watering Troughs and a small Pond - These will be supplied from A Line from the irrigation pipe - source of supply will be from pond constructed AS per drawings -

Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.07 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Butternut Creek, seepage and winter runoff, and reservoir to be constructed under application R-59345, permit R-8115

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation and stock use being 0.06 cfs for irrigation and 0.005 cfs for stock use from Butternut Creek and 0.005 cfs from seepage and winter runoff for irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further water shall not be appropriated from direct flow during the period from July 31 through September 15 of each year.

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is September 20, 1979

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 21, 1981 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1982

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1983
