DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

A 7.5 Horse Power 1 1/2 inch "Cornell" pump, capable to deliver 160 gallon per minate, is to be placed near the waters edge of Slate Creek at point of water intake as indicated on the supporting map for this application.

Water from the pump is to be carried in a solid set 1 1/2 inch pipe to a distribution box approx. 200 feet south from the pump site.

Movable pipes will be connected there to feed sprinklers alternately as water is available to distances up to 800 feet from the point of distribution for irrigation of pasture and limited garden area.

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Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.33 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Slate Creek

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is July 2, 1979

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 21, 1981 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1982

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1983

Extended to Oct. 1, 1984
