DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

WATER RESOURCES DEPT

Include dimensions and type of construction of diversion dam and headgate, length and dimensions of supply ditch or pipeline, size and type of pump and motor, type of irrigation system to adequately describe the proposed distribution system.

Spring area has been ditched & filled with washed rock with a 4" perforated pipe embedded in rock so as to serve as a catch basin; then piped into a plastic pipe which runs about 400' to storage tank #2 then on with the 500' to storage tank #3 thence to two homes & a barn. The barn is used for livestock, one home being in the N.W. 1/4 of the N.W. 1/4 of Sec. 17 Township 28S Range 13 W.W.M. Co. Oregon, the second home & barn being in the N.E. 1/4 of N.E. 1/4 of Sec. 18 Township 28S Range 13 W.W.M. Co. Oregon. Home no. 3 is about 1700' from storage tank #3.

As planned at this time of application home #1 as indicated on map will be built in the future & it will require 400' to 500' of plastic pipe & probably a booster pump to serve same.

Permit to appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.025 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from a spring

The use to which this water is to be applied is stock and domestic use for 3 families including not to exceed 1/2 acre lawn and non-commercial garden irrigation for each family, being 0.005 cfs for stock use and 0.02 cfs for domestic use

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is December 24, 1979

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 21, 1981 and shall

thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1982

Extended to Oct. 1, 1984 Extended to Oct. 1, 1986

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1983
