Creek- 2630 feet North and 2570 feet East from SW Cor. S. 17 being within NE 1/4 SW 1/4 (If there is more than one point of diversion, each must be described)

Spring - 1830 feet North and 380 feet East from SW Cor. S.17 being within NW 1/4 SW 1/4

being within the 1/4 of the 1/4 of Sec. 17 Tp. 22S. R. 7W., W. M., in the county of Douglas (N. or S.) (E. or W.)

Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.45 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from a spring and Elk Creek being 0.01 cfs from the spring and 0.44 cfs from Elk Creek

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic use for one family including not to exceed 1/2 acre lawn and non-commercial garden irrigation and irrigation being 0.01 cfs for domestic use from the spring and 0.44 cfs for irrigation from Elk Creek

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is December 13, 1979

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 16, 1981 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1982

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1983
