Permit to appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.035 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from ...South Umpqua River.....

The use to which this water is to be applied is...domestic use for one family, stock use..... and irrigation being 0.005 cfs for domestic use, 0.005 cfs for stock use and..... 0.025 cfs for irrigation.....

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated... and shall be further limited to a diversion of not... to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation..... season of each year.....
