make application for a permit to appropriate the following described waters of the State of Oregon:

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is HEATER RESERVOIR, a tributary of DRIFT CREEK

2. The point of diversion is to be located 320 ft. S (N. or S.) and 720 ft. E (E. or W.) from the NW corner of SW 1/4 SE 1/4 SECTION 8 (Public Land Survey Corner)

(If there is more than one point of diversion, each must be described)

being within the SW 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Sec. 8 Tp. 8 S R. 1 E, W. M., in the county of MARION

3. Location of area to be irrigated, or place of use if other than irrigation.

Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 30.0 acre-feet stored water only cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Heater Reservoir to be constructed under Application No. R-59816 Permit No. R-8149

The use to which this water is to be applied is supplemental irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year provided that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior rights existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

February 25, 1980 for 21.0 acre-feet

The priority date of this permit is August 4, 1980 for 9.0 acre-feet

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 7, 1981 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1982

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1983
