APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Roy Edgmond (Name of Applicant)
of Enterprise, County of Wallowa
State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon subject to existing rights:

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Hurricane (Name of stream)

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.10 cubic feet per second.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is irrigation (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located at SW cor sec 34 (Give distance and bearing to section corner)

being within the SW SW of Sec. 35, Tp. 2 S (No. N. or S.)

5. The ditch is to be 6 miles in length, terminating in the of Sec. Tp. (Smallest legal subdivision) (No. N. or S.)

R., W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map. (No. E. or W.)

6. The name of the ditch, canal or other works is Alder Slope Ditch

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

DIVERSION WORKS—

*This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, sub-
ject to the following limitations and conditions: If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to
one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent, for each acre irrigated, and shall be subject
to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.*

~~.....The right to the use of water herein granted is limited to irrigation purposes.....~~

*The amount of water appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial
use and not to exceed0.01..... cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of
