make application for a permit to appropriate the following described waters of the State of Oregon:

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is unnamed spring area, a tributary of Woodcock Creek

2. The point of diversion is to be located 2100 ft. S and 2300 ft. E from the NW corner of Section 31 (Public Land Survey Corner)

(If there is more than one point of diversion, each must be described)

being within the SE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Sec. 31 Tp. 39S R. 8W, W.M., in the county of Josephine

3. Location of area to be irrigated, or place of use if other than irrigation.

4. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 01 cfs

5. The use to which the water is to be applied is domestic use including irrigation of a lawn & garden (non-commercial) not to exceed 1/2 acre in area

6. DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Include dimensions and type of construction of diversion dam and headgate, length and dimensions of supply ditch or pipeline, size and type of pump and motor, type of irrigation system to adequately describe the proposed distribution system.

The dam is cement block ^{and cement} 3-4 feet high and 10 feet wide. The pipe is 4" PVC at dam and diminishes to 1" pipe at house. It is about 1/2 mile long. It runs on gravity flow.

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Remarks:

The dam was built and put in use by previous owner in approximately 1970. We have lived in this house and used the water since 1974. The pipe crosses a neighbor's land. They have given verbal permission for the pipe.

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Permit to appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from an unnamed spring area

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic use for one family, including the irrigation of lawn and garden not to exceed one-half acre in area

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is December 5, 1979

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 25, 1981 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1982

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1983
