A parcel of land in the Northeast Quarter of Section 36, Township 39 South, Range 8 West of the Willamette Meridian, Josephine County, Oregon, being more particularly described as follows: Beginning at the Northeast corner of said Section 36; thence along the East line of said Section 36, South 195.00 feet to an iron rod on the Southerly right of way line of White School Road; thence along said right of way line, South 89° 36' 15" West 1978.00 feet to an iron rod which is the true point of beginning; thence continue along said right of way line, South 89° 36' 15" West 332.00 feet to an iron rod; thence South 655.73 feet to an iron rod on the North right of way line of Aquarius Way; thence along said North right of way line, North 89° 44' East 332.00 feet to an iron rod; thence North 656.48 feet to the true point of beginning.

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Permit to appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same **SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD** and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.10 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Kelly Creek

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to one-fiftieth of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is January 25, 1980

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 25, 1981 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1982

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1983
