make application for a permit to appropriate the following described waters of the State of Oregon:

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is UNNAMED INTERMITTENT STREAM, SURFACE RUN-OFF AND RESERVOIR, a tributary of ASH SWALE

2. The point of diversion is to be located 3140 ft. N and 300 ft. W from the SE corner of SECTION 22 T6S R4W (Public Land Survey Corner)

being within the SE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Sec. 22 Tp. 6S R. 4W, W. M., in the county of POLK (N. or S.) (E. or W.)

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Permit to appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.08 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from an unnamed stream, surface runoff and reservoir to be constructed under application No. R-60498, permit No. R-8174.

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir to be constructed under permit No. R-8174.

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is August 15, 1980

Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 19, 1981 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1982

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1983
