1. The source of the proposed appropriation is WILLIAMSON RIVER, a tributary of Hamath Lake

2. The point of diversion is to be located 2970 ft. N and 1320 ft. E from the SW corner of SECTION 21 (Public Land Survey Corner)

At point of diversion I wish to install a 35-40 hp pump. An 8" main line will traverse the length of the field that I wish to have in alfalfa. ~~1/4~~ 1/4" main line will run north & south on this field with the addition of pack line for the area to the pond and a big gun for the area north of road and ~~pastures~~. ~~The 23 acres of pasture is to the east of the alfalfa field & will be irrigated with pack lines.~~ My real need for water from the W. River comes from the fact that I can bring three phase power across the river to the point of diversion. It is the only way that I can economically bring 3 phase power to my ~~place~~ place. ~~Alas we are applying for a FIB loan for development & they require it to be irrigated from the river.~~

Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 2.73 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Williamson River

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/40th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is October 22, 1979

Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 19, 1981 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1982

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1983
