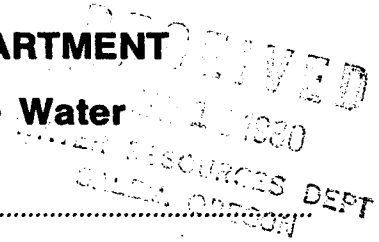

 a tributary of Umpqua River

2. The point of diversion is to be located 400 ft. S and 2860 ft. W  
(N. or S.) (E. or W.)  
 from the N<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> corner of Sec. 34  
(Public Land Survey Corner)

6. DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Include dimensions and type of construction of diversion dam and headgate, length and dimensions of supply ditch or pipeline, size and type of pump and motor, type of irrigation system to adequately describe the proposed distribution system.

The works will be tied into our present system of irrigation for which rights have been granted to water the existing 105 acres. The present system uses a 50 HP pump at the North Umpqua, drawing a 6" intake and pushing a 4" pipe approximately 500' to a holding pond; then from the holding pond 3, 50 HP pumps operate into a standard Toro golf course system on command of electrical timing or manual command.

The addition is an extension of this system and is timed in to add coverage to the additional 55 acres of the total 160. The system has been designed to utilize the natural terrain to return to the holding pond the excessive water. The new system includes selective watering. Also, included is a collective drainage system to return and reclaim water both from irrigation and rain or snow.



### Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.68 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from North Umpqua River

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is May 14, 1980

Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 19, 1981 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1982

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1983
