make application for a permit to appropriate the following described waters of the State of Oregon:

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Columbia River, a tributary of Pacific Ocean

2. The point of diversion is to be located 460 ft. N and 1680 ft. E from the SW corner of Sec. 7 (Public Land Survey Corner)

(If there is more than one point of diversion, each must be described)

being within the SE 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Sec. 7 Tp. 5N R. 30 E W. M., in the county of Umatilla

3. Location of area to be irrigated, or place of use if other than irrigation.

4. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 4.98

5. The use to which the water is to be applied is irrigation

6. **DESCRIPTION OF WORKS**

Include dimensions and type of construction of diversion dam and headgate, length and dimensions of supply ditch or pipeline, size and type of pump and motor, type of irrigation system to adequately describe the proposed distribution system.

Water to be Supplied from G2L Ranch (Phil Cohn) and Formerly Robert W. Bradshaw from their point of diversion as established under permit 36169, Certificate 44905.

Irrigation system will be the same as used formerly under our permit G-5699.

Permit to appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 4.98 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Columbia River

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/40th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is May 23, 1980

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 14, 1981 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1982

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1983
