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Remarks: Water is to be primarily used for washing clothes, showers, washing cars, irrigation of garden and flowers, and other light domestic uses. Source will not be used for human consumption.

This usage is for an RV Park and Campground, including 2 cabins, 2 houses, 2 mobiles, 12 RV hook ups, 18 spaces w/water & lights. The river water is connected to the wash room and several outlets; however, none are connected to homes or mobiles. Major domestic use is from wells on the property. This right is to legalize an existing use.

This permit, when issued, is for the beneficial use of water. By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan. It is possible that the land use you propose may not be allowed if it is not in keeping with the goals and the acknowledged plan. Your city or county planning agency can advise you about the land-use plan in your area.

Permit to appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed0.08..... cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from ...West Fork Illinois River.....

The use to which this water is to be applied is...domestic use in RV park campground and..... irrigation... being 0.01 cfs for domestic and 0.08 cfs for irrigation; provided further that the total amount diverted shall not at any time exceed 0.08 cfs.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/50th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated..... and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,


and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is June 17, 1980

Actual construction work shall begin on or before..... October 14, 1981 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19.82.....

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19.83.....
