Permit to appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from an unnamed spring

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic use of one family including irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre noncommercial lawn and garden.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated.

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is June 23, 1980.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 14, 1981 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1982.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1983.
