1. The source of the proposed appropriation is South Fork Alsea River  
Alsea River, a tributary of Alsea River

The most northerly 20 acres of that portion of Tax Lot No. 300, Section 18, Township 14 South, Range 7 West, W.M. Benton County, Oregon lying to the east of an existing fence running along the east bank of the South Fork of the Alsea River and to the west of Benton County Road No. 2.

**DESCRIPTION OF WORKS**

The pump is a 3x4, 33 H.P. Berkeley diesel. Irrigation will be  
through movable 3 inch irrigation pipe with an initial investment  
in 50 sprinkler heads spaced 60 feet apart on the irrigation  
lines. 500 ft. of 4 inch main line will be acquired.

7. Construction work will begin on or before August 1, 1980

8. Construction work will be completed on or before August 15, 1980

9. The water will be completely applied to the proposed use on or before August 30, 1980

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*Remarks:* Please note that the attached USDA Soil Conservation Map shows a total of 90.2 acres in the Hennings field. This application is for those 20 acres which were not filed for under the original Hennings water right application recorded at Page 20392, Volume 15, State Record of Water Right Certificates (70.0 acres; cancellation thereof pending under appeal to Oregon Court of Appeals).

This permit, when issued, is for the beneficial use of water. By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan. It is possible that the land use you propose may not be allowed if it is not in keeping with the goals and the acknowledged plan. Your city or county planning agency can advise you about the land-use plan in your area.

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### Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.25 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from South Fork Alsea River

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is July 9, 1980

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 14, 1981 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1982

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1983
