6. DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Include dimensions and type of construction of diversion dam and headgate, length and dimensions of supply ditch or pipeline, size and type of pump and motor, type of irrigation system to adequately describe the proposed distribution system.

Propose to set up on the bank, located within a pump house, a one (1) h.p. jet pump to obtain water from river and pumping up to home site which is approximately 1,200 feet, (thru 1 1/4" PVC pipe with 200 pound test) - to the site for the reservoir and pressure tank, at the home site. Would then put in filtering system and 3/4 h.p. pump for use in pumping from the reservoir.

Attached is copy of the major land partition approved 5/25/79. This shows legal description of all three (3) parcels. Also enclose a plat of this major land partition of the three parcels. As noted, this reflects location of proposed water line from the river to the proposed location site of the home in PARCEL 2. It is for parcel # 2 that I have purchased and am applying for a permit.

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Permit to appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from North Umpqua River

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic use for one family including lawn and noncommercial garden not to exceed one-half acre in area

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is August 4, 1980

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 26, 1981 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1982

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1983
