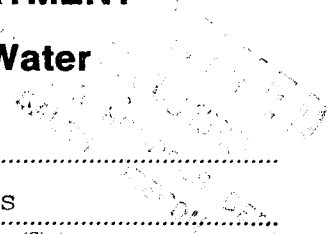

make application for a permit to appropriate the following described waters of the State of Oregon

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Unnamed stream and Reservoir

a tributary of Langlois Creek

2. The point of diversion is to be located 450 ft. S and 550 ft. E

4. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.0556

cubic feet per second.

5. The use to which the water is to be applied is irrigation of pasture and garden.

6. DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Include dimensions and type of construction of diversion dam and headgate, length and dimensions of supply ditch or pipeline, size and type of pump and motor, type of irrigation system to adequately describe the proposed distribution system.

Stream is to be impounded by an eight foot high earthen fill dam which will provide water storage. The water will be pumped from the reservoir by an electric pump (up to 5 h.p.) using irrigation pipe (up to 4 inch diameter). Irrigation is intended to be by aerial spraying (rain bird or similar) or by surface soaking using one or more distribution lines to cover pasyure area.

7. Construction work will begin on or before September 1, 1980

8. Construction work will be completed on or before September 1, 1981

9. The water will be completely applied to the proposed use on or before September 1, 1982

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Permit to appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.06 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from an unnamed stream and reservoir to be constructed under application No. R-59890, permit No. R- 8190.

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir to be constructed under permit No. R-

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is March 18, 1980

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 26, 1981 and shall

thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1983

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1983
