make application for a permit to appropriate the following described waters of the State of Oregon:

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is a small spring, a tributary of Waahink Lake

2. The point of diversion is to be located 1320 ft. S and 1090 ft. W from the N.E. corner of Sec. 14 (Public Land Survey Corner)

Spring is located well within Tax Lot 1801 - approx. 22' south of property line to the north, and approx. 12' east of property line to the west

being within the S.E. 1/4 of the N.E. 1/4 of Sec. 14 Tp. 19 R. 12, W.M., in the county of Lane

3. Location of area to be irrigated, or place of use if other than irrigation.

Table with 5 columns: Township, Range, Section, List 1/4 1/4 of Section, List use and/or number of acres to be irrigated. Row 1: 19, 12, 14, S.E. of NE, Domestic & 1/2 acre

4. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.01
cubic feet per second. 2 Gall/min or 4.5 see letter 9-23-80 PAB
(If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

5. The use to which the water is to be applied is Domestic use ^{including} irrigation of 1/2 ac
being 1 gal/min for domestic, and 1 gal/min for irrigation.

6. DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Include dimensions and type of construction of diversion dam and headgate, length and dimensions of supply ditch or pipeline, size and type of pump and motor, type of irrigation system to adequately describe the proposed distribution system.

I intend to install a 400 gall collection tank below
the spring and pump the water up hill about 80'
to a system that has not yet being determined.

7. Construction work will begin on or before Nov 1 - 80

8. Construction work will be completed on or before Nov. 1 81.

9. The water will be completely applied to the proposed use on or before Nov 1, 82

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Remarks: For the last 2 years we have been using our lot for vacation & week end use w a traveltrailer. We would like to hook up a water system to the traveltrailer the sooner the better. We intend to build our house there in 1982.

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Permit to appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from a spring

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic use of one family including irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre noncommercial lawn and garden.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is July 9, 1980

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 26, 1981 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1982

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1983
